The Offsite Gallery is located on the 1st floor of the World Trade Center at 101 W. Main St., Norfolk, VA 23510. Exhibitions rotate every 6-8 weeks. Norfolk Arts encourages contemporary approaches that take visitors to a new level of participation and engagement.

This call is open to artists 18 years or older, residing in the United States. There is no fee to apply. Proposed exhibitions may be solo or group and are open to all visual arts media. Special consideration will be given to local artists and to proposals that include a community engagement component such as a performance, hands-on workshop or artist talk. Artists are required to submit 5-10 images representing a cohesive body of original artwork and a written proposal for committee review. Norfolk Arts will consider the diversity and beliefs and values and general standards of decency of citizens. Norfolk Arts will hang artwork, unless unusual requirements are necessary. Any unusual expenses regarding installation and removal are the artist's responsibility. Norfolk Arts will host an opening reception, print invitations, and advertise on social media. Artists are responsible for delivery and pick up of artwork. Norfolk Arts does not pay for any shipping of artwork and takes no commission on sales.

- 2.) Information about the subject of the work and intent of your exhibition
- 3.) 5-10 JPEG images that accurately represent a cohesiveness of work to be exhibited
- 4.) An image list to include titles, medium, dimensions, and year work was completed
- 5.) Idea for a community engagement component to your exhibition
- 6.) Name, address, phone, email, and dates preferred from exhibition schedule above
